Appellation: Barossa Valley

Varietals: 45% Grenache, 33% Shiraz, 20% Merlot, 2% Mourvedre

ALC/VOL: 15.0%

Analysis: pH 3.49 : Acid 6.28 : Residual Sugar 1.9 g/l

Season: 2006 was a fast ripening Barossa season, being mild in November & December and warm in January. Yields were average and styles were concentrated. The expression of varietal flavours in Shiraz and Merlot was very good.

Nose: Lifted floral aromas with hints of beetroot and stewed plum.

Palate: The palate shows luscious cherry & berry fruit flavours balanced with good acidity and firm tannin structure. The wine finishes dry with lingering fruit cake flavours.

Food: This wine is approachable now ideally suit a wide range cuisine.
